54" Holiday Tree Skirt

FREE SEWING PATTERN

54" Holiday Tree Skirt

What You Need:

- 2 yards of fabric for the top*
- · 2 yards of fabric for the bottom**
- Thread
- · Rotary blade or fabric scissors
- Sewing Machine
- · Washable fabric marker or chalk
- Pins
- Optional: 4 yards of pom pom trim

*We're using designs from Caley's Christmas Cuteness Collection to create a Fill-a-Yard™ Cheater Quilt.

**We're using Caley's <u>Snowflakes &</u> <u>Flurries</u> on Minky.

Recommended Fabrics:

- Organic Cotton Sateen (top)
- Minky (bottom)

To Print + Assemble:

- Printer
- · Printer paper
- · Scissors to cut paper
- Tape

Additional Notes:

First, you'll want to create your Fill-A-Yard® Cheater Quilt project. You can choose to stick with a solid design for the top or highlight a few different designs.

Step 1

Cut a 54" square from both your top and bottom fabrics.

Step 2

Fold each square in half twice (top to bottom, then left to right) to form a 27" square.

Step 3

From the folded corner, measure and cut a 27" arc for the outer edge. Then measure and cut a 2" arc for the center opening (tree trunk hole).

Step 4

Unfold both pieces and cut along one fold line from the center hole to the outer edge.

Step 5

With right sides together, pin and stitch around the edges with a ½" seam allowance, leaving a 4" opening along one edge.

Step 6

Turn right side out, topstitch around the edge, and close the opening. If using the Cheater Quilt Fill-a-Yard® template, quilt as desired. Optional: Add pom pom trim for a fun finish!
